






30% of K-12 students lack adequate connectivity and/or technology



GEER Funding

- Governor's Emergency Education Relief Funds
- \$11.5 million in year 1
- Shared among 7 Pennsylvania PBS stations
- Datacasting: equipment (antennas/receivers), professional development, and technology upgrades at the stations
- Distance learning: Standards-aligned educational broadcast/ materials



A Local Story: County Funding

- May 2020 Governor of PA signed legislation
- \$625 million CARES Act funding available to counties to support pandemic related activities (block grants)
- Lehigh Valley Reads Waterford UPSTART pilot (PBS39/WLVT)
- \$100,000 to close the gap
- Online pre-k with laptop/internet
